

Located just 1 1/2 hours from Philadelphia and Baltimore, Dauphin Highlands is nestled in Swatara Township, a suburb of Harrisburg, Pa.

#### FROM THE PHILADELPHIA AREA (EAST)

I-76 West, take exit 247 (Harrisburg East/Harrisburg/ Hershey). Merge onto PA-283 West, via Exit 1B toward PA-230/Highspire. Turn right onto S. Eisenhower Blvd. Turn left onto Quarry Road, take the first right onto S. Harrisburg Street. Golf course will be on your left at the top of the hill.

#### FROM THE BALTIMORE/YORK AREA (SOUTH)

Take I-83 North toward Harrisburg. Merge onto I-283 toward (airport/lancaster Pennsylvania Turnpike). Take Exit 2 (PA-441) toward Swatara. Keep right on ramp, turn right onto PA-441/Lindle Road. Turn left onto S. Eisenhower Blvd, turn right onto Quarry Road, take first right onto S. Harrisburg Street. Golf course will be on your left at the top of the hill.

### FROM HARRISBURG (WEST)

Take I-83 North toward Harrisburg. Merge onto I-283 toward (airport/lancasterPennsylvania Turnpike). Take Exit 2 (PA-441) toward Swatara. Keep right on ramp, turn right onto PA-441/Lindle Road. Turn left onto S. Eisenhower Blvd, turn right onto Quarry Road, take first right onto S. Harrisburg Street. Golf course will be on your left at the top of the hill.




