

More Fundraising Ideas for Teams/Committees

- Car Wash – Could be held at local churches or fast food restaurants.
- Profit Sharing – Contact local restaurants gather interest in profit sharing. The restaurant will determine the percentage of proceeds received and how to market the event. Examples: Chick-fil-A, California Pizza Kitchen, Moe’s Southwest Grill, etc.
- Bowling Tournament – Charge an initial entry fee, winner of tournament receives a small donated prize
- Brewery Tour/Tasting – Contact local breweries. Charge entry fee, facility provides food and drink.
- Garage Sale- Have one team member host a garage sale with all other team members helping and supplying materials. Advertise!
- Dance Marathon – Find a local bar/restaurant and DJ to host a dance marathon. Charge an entry fee and provide a donated prize for the winner.
- Bachelor/Bachelorette Auction
- Donation Jars – Ask local organizations to put a donation jar on their front counters
- Gas Station Attendants – Find a local gas station willing to help. Become “attendants for a day.” Offer to pump gas and clean windshields. Have a small donation bucket and explain the cause.
- Silent Auction – Have items/services donated by team members and/or local organizations.
- Poker Tournament – Find rental business to donate poker tables/chips in exchange for free advertising. Charge entry fee. Winner receives trophy/donated prize. (Check local laws for charity poker events)
- Movie Marathon – Find a local theater to host a movie marathon (could be overnight). Choose a fun theme. Charge small entry fee and sell discounted snacks/drinks. Or, ask the movie theater to profit share with concession sales.
- Pancake Breakfast – can be hosted at local churches, schools, or community centers. Charge small entry fee.
- Register for Text Donations – Enter a short code number and keyword, and donations can be received via text message. (must be a qualified organization)
- Dance – Have a theme (80’s, Adults Only Prom, Mother/Daughter, Father/Daughter, etc.). Contact a local church or community center to host. Charge entry fee and sell concessions.
- Spaghetti Dinner – Contact local church or community center to host. Charge small entry fee. Try to get all ingredients donated.

- Karaoke Contest – Contact local karaoke joints for a donated room rental. Charge a small contest entry fee. Winner receives donated prize. Ask about profit sharing from drinks/food purchased.
- Womanless Beauty Pageant – Find men to participate in a role-reversal pageant (they put on dresses, walk down the runway, have a “talent,” etc.) Charge a small entry fee and have volunteers sell concessions.
- No Upfront Cost fundraisers – Cookie dough tubs, trail mix, wrapping paper, candles, etc. Receive up to 65% profit.
- Parent’s Night Out – Contact local church/community center to host. Offer to babysit children while couples have a night out. Charge small fee.
- Dinner For a Week- Have 7 restaurants donate a dinner for 2. Raffle off a week of eating out. Charge \$20-\$30 for tickets. Winners will be able to eat out every night for a week.
- Speed Dating – Register a set number of bachelors. Charge about \$20 for women to sign up. Have volunteers keep up with time, etc.
- Online Fundraiser – simply set up an online donation site. Market the site through social media- Facebook, Twitter, Tumblr, etc.
- Test Drive – Work with local car dealerships to host a test drive event. Charge a fee for driving. Each dealership will be different in what they are able to donate. (Ex. One dollar for every mile driven, \$5 for test drive of every vehicle, etc)
