The first-ever county-level estimates of the prevalence of people with Alzheimer's dementia in all 3,142 United States counties — were released on Monday, July 17 at the Alzheimer's Association International Conference® (AAIC®) 2023 in Amsterdam, Netherlands and online.

Researchers found the highest prevalence of Alzheimer's were in the east and southeastern regions of the United States, with the highest in Maryland at 12.9%. For counties with a population of 10,000 or more individuals age 65 or older, they estimate the highest Alzheimer's prevalence rates were in Baltimore City, MD, at 16.6 % and Prince George's County, MD at 16.1%. The state and county specific estimates could help public health officials to understand the burden of disease (e.g., demand for caregiver counseling and institutional care) and develop strategies for identifying and caring for people with Alzheimer's dementia.
