FAQ & General Information:

Does every participant get a T-shirt?

Every registered participant who achieves the fundraising minimum of \$150 will receive an official Walk to End Alzheimer's T-shirt via USPS. To receive a shirt in time for Walk day, participants must raise the T-shirt minimum of \$150 by **September 3, 2024**.

How long is the Walk?

3.1 mile loop through the Burncoat neighborhood.

Is there a shorter route option?

Yes! We have a 1 mile loop that does not have any hills. The route will be marked with signs that say "Short Route". The turn off is at Burncoat Street and North Parkway.

Is there free parking?

Yes! We have ample free parking available at 100 North Parkway, our volunteers will direct you when you arrive. You're welcome to park on the street along North Parkway.

Are pets, strollers, bicycles and skates allowed on Walk day?

We do allow strollers, but for everyone's safety, we discourage skateboards, bicycles, inline skates and wheelie footwear. We are thrilled to share that we now allow our furry friends to the Walk. We will have a Doggie Station sponsored by Castinetti Realty Group.

Is there water and food available?

We will have one water stop sponsored and donated by Polar Beverages. We do encourage people who require more hydration to bring their own bottles or water packs. An assortment of donated packaged food items will be available at the "Food Tent" before the Walk.

What activities will be there on Walk day?

Participants are Welcome at 8:30 am. We welcome participants to pick their Promise Flower, visit our Community Mission Tent, take their Team Photo, visit our Artisan at Hudson Memory Wall, Next Step Healthcare Selfie Station, United Healthcare Team Poster Area,, Champions Tent (where you pick up your Champion Medal) and the Kids Zone. Grab your flower and join us at the Main Stage for the Promise Ceremony at 10:00 am.

Where are the restrooms?

There will be porta-potties located to the right of the Walk site entrance from the parking lot. We do have ADA accessible toilets available. We will not have porta-potties along the Walk route.

What happens if it rains?

Walk is a rain or shine event. However, in the case of severe weather, we will cancel. If this is the case, we will update our Walk homepage on or before the morning of the event.
