

Scholarship Award Guidelines

Who can apply?

- Volunteers, family caregivers, persons with memory loss, support group facilitators, agency/facility staff members and students who do not have the financial resources for the registration fee are eligible for scholarships. Final notification of scholarship awards will be made by April 29, 2019.
- Funding limitations may preclude support to those who had received scholarship support in the past two years.
- Scholarships will be awarded to no more than **two (2) staff members** from one agency.
- Students will be considered if they are actively working in the field.
- Priority is given to Alzheimer's Association volunteers.

Attention Support Group Facilitators . . .

The Alzheimer's Association gives funding priority to support group facilitators affiliated with the Association. Please consider this opportunity to enhance your expertise.

Submission Notes:

- Scholarship awards cover conference registration fees only. Travel & lodging expenses are NOT included. We cannot guarantee 100% funding, but will do our best to meet your needs.
- No applications will be accepted after the deadline – **March 15, 2019**. Be sure your application is postmarked no later than March 15, 2019.
- Be sure to include your conference registration form along with your scholarship application.
- Scholarship recipients will be notified by email or phone no later than April 29, 2019.
- If a scholarship recipient cannot accept the award, they are required to notify the conference planner as soon as possible. This scholarship will be passed on to another applicant.
